Please, NO DOGS on the trail. Dogs in camp must be inside your camper, trailer or leashed. Our host asks that you clean up after your dogs in camp.

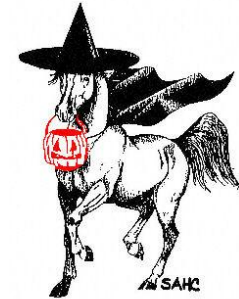

Catered dinner by Cascade Mountain Grilling, and Live entertainment.

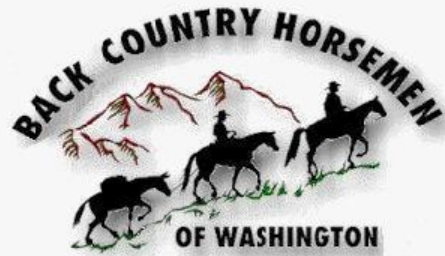
Camping is available for pre-registration only

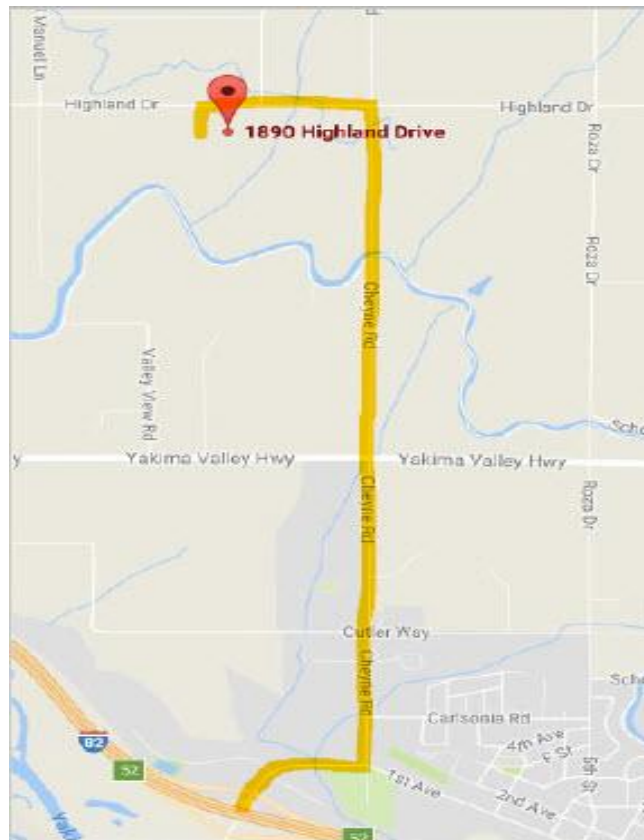

DIRECTIONS TO 1890 HIGHLAND

Traveling East on I-82 (from Seattle / Ellensburg / Yakima), take Exit 52 toward Zillah. Turn Left onto Meyers Rd. Next, take the 2nd Left onto Cheyne Road. Go past the school and then go straight through the stop sign at Yakima Valley Hwy. Continue North approximately 1-mile more, then turn left onto Highland Drive. Our new location is about ¼-mile from the intersection, on the left—watch for signs.

Traveling West on I-82 (from Walla Walla/Tri-Cities/Sunnyside), take Exit 54 toward Zillah. Turn Right at Yakima Valley Hwy. Stay on Yakima Valley Hwy (curves to the left). Turn Right at Cheyne Road. Go North, approximately 1 mile and turn left onto Highland Drive. Our new location is about ¼-mile from the intersection, on the left—watch for signs. Property address is 2100 Roza Drive Zillah, WA
