**Where: Kalama Horse Camp**

**Weed-Seed Free forage is REQUIRED on all National Forest Lands.**



**DIRECTIONS:** Take I-5 to Exit 21-Woodland. Proceed east through town on WA-503 E toward Cougar and continue east for approximately 25 miles (past Yale Park). Watch for road to the left with green road sign to Lake Merrill and Kalama Horse Camp (8100 Road). Proceed on this road for approximately 8 miles and turn right. You will see the entrance to Kalama Horse Camp. There will be volunteers available to help with parking.

**NOTE: If you reach Cougar before turning onto the 8100 road, you've gone too far and missed the turn off.**

Short and long loop rides available along some of the most exceptional trails in this area. Trail maps provided on site.

**Liability waiver must be signed at the time of registration.**

**Kalama Horse Camp is now a reservation/fee camp.  
The Mount St. Helens Chapter has reserved as many sites as possible to accommodate participants. Please be prepared to share sites.**
