Now that you're registered, we have some useful information for you regarding the ride:

When you arrive at the ranch, our Parking hosts will assist you in finding a suitable camping area, you may bring your own stalls or highlines. Please be considerate of other campers.

You will also need to check in at the Welcome Wagon to receive your information packets.

The silent auction (with a fantastic selection of items) will conclude Saturday @ 4:30 pm and posted before the live auction. We will also be selling \$5.00 raffle tickets until 5:30 pm on Saturday.

The Live Auction will be held during dessert ***We will be having a new auction in connection with the LIVE auction. It is called "Pick of the Live" There will be 200 tickets sold at \$5.00 apiece. The winner is entitled to select whatever item they want from the LIVE auction items before the auction.***

Additionally, we'd like to remind you of the following information, rules & suggestions:

- If you did not reserve a stall, you will need to highline your stock at or near your trailer or set up a temporary corral.
- You are responsible for feed for your stock.
- There is a water hose available for you to water your stock and manure disposal equipment is available for your use. Please coil the hose up when not in use.
- When leaving your campsite other than for riding, please be sure your horse is secure to avoid any loose horses in camp that could cause injury to either them or campers, especially after dark. *Thank you!*
- Hopefully you didn't forget to bring sunscreen!! Hats are also suggested with the hot temperatures in July, and hydrate – hydrate – hydrate!!
- The only campfire allowed is the Community campfire in the main Dining Area near the Ranch House.
- In case of an emergency back home, campers without cell phones can be contacted on the Ranch, at (509) 674-2366.
- **In the event that you bring a dog, they must be leashed at all times.** They are **NOT** allowed in the picnic area or outside of the camping/parking areas. You are responsible to keep your dogs quiet so as not to disturb other campers. ***PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.***
- NO stallions at the Western Dream Ride – *thank you for understanding!*
- Quiet time in the camping areas is 10:00 pm, which includes turning off generators please!
- There will be a Veterinarian, and also a Ferrier on call – but not on site for emergencies. You are responsible for any fees related to their services.
- Please respect all areas of Private Property.
- Suitable swimwear only in the pool please; no ragged material, cut-offs, metal rivets, etc. Also, no glass (bottles, glassware) in the pool area.
- When consuming alcohol please use wisdom and moderation.
- Please clean your camp area and clean your stalls before you leave for the weekend.

Make sure to attend our "Riders Meeting" at 8am, Saturday prior to riding out of the Ranch.
