BCHW WINERY RIDE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

PRE-RIDE:

- 1. Our Day Ride Parking is located at 5330 Lombard Loop Rd, Zillah WA.
- **2.** Do not arrive prior to 7:00 AM on Saturday morning.

3. There will be a \$15 service fee for any refund requests.

Rules:

- 1. No unattended stock may be left on-site.
- 2. Only registered participants may park on the property during this event. Each registered vehicle must place their parking pass in the windshield of your vehicle.
- **3.** Stock water is available in an emergency, we do ask that you bring your own.
- 4. Chemical toilet will be available for registered riders.
- 5. For use of this property, Riders are required to clean up their parking spot by taking any wasted hay or manure home with you. DO NOT DUMP MANURE IN GARBAGE CANS OR DUMPSTERS ON SITE. Leaving your waste and manure adds additional work for our volunteers. BCHW believes in LEAVE NO TRACE BY BEING LIGHT ON THE LAND. Please practice this. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE RIDE OR LEFT OUTSIDE YOUR RIGS WHILE YOU ARE GONE.
- 6. This year we have changed how we award our prizes. The prizes will be at base camp where Velen Winery is (It's on the trail map) You will have the opportunity to choose where you place your tickets for a chance to win a prize. Prize tickets can be purchased at base camp.

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE RIDE:

Length of ride is up to riders, with two different loops to choose from. Our West loop runs a total of 12-miles, or about 4 to 5 hours ride. The East loop runs a total of 8-miles or 3 to 4-hours riding if ridden straight through with no stops. The West loop has a shorter optional route for those wishing to cut down the mileage. A Winery card will be in your packets so you will know which loop you are starting out on.

Dogs are not allowed in registration areas or on the trails.

1. Each rider determines their time on the trail by the amount of time they spend at each winery and their horses' pace. There's ample opportunity to spend plenty of wine tasting time. Riders go out as early as 9:30 am and return as late as 5:30 pm, at their discretion but PLEASE be back to your trailers before dark and be safe.

Take your plastic wine glass with you to the wineries.

- **2.** Terrain is mostly even with some low rolling hills. This is farm/orchard country (and vineyards, of course). Mostly dirt, some gravel, some pavement (short distances).
- **3.** There can be up to a total of 12 participating wineries, if all owners again choose to participate. An average of 6 wineries are on each loop depending on participation. (3 of them are on both loops).
- 4. Some wineries have hitch rails; some have trailers to tie too. At times these wineries can get very crowed and you will either need to wait for a tie spot or you will need to share horse holding duties. Please do not tie to trees or grape posts.
- 5. If your horse is prone to kicking in tight situations, please tie a red ribbon on the tail.
- 6. Please respect the wineries business, do not consume any alcohol other than wine purchased specifically from that winery while on their property. Violating this may cause the wineries to have their license revoked or fined by the State of Washington.
- **7.** Some of the wineries do charge a tasting fee. This fee is separate from ride fees and does not go to BCHW. There will be a list of wineries tasting fees available as handouts. BCHW has no control over wine tasting fees.
- 8. Wear your rider number (Wrist Band) so that it is visible at all times. This establishes your legitimate right to be on the winery's property.

Food:

Some wineries may have food available.

WINE PICK UP AND PRIZES:

- 1. Wine purchases and prizes for Day Riders will be transported by BCHW and delivered to the Day Parking area in the late afternoon on Saturday.
- **2.** All wine and prizes must be picked up before you head home and no later than 8:00 PM on Saturday.
- **3.** Most wineries are closed by 6:00 PM and we do our best to have all wine ready for pick up by 6:30 PM.

Traveling East on I-82 Take exit #50, turn left onto Buena Rd and head north. Stay on Buena and go past Yakima Valley Hwy. Turn left to stay on Buena. Turn Right on Knight Hill Rd and continue to Lombard Loop Rd. Turn right and go to the Knight Hill Winery, 5330 Lombard Loop Rd.

Traveling West on I-82 Take exit #50, turn right onto Buena Rd and head north. Stay on Buena and go past Yakima Valley Hwy. Turn left to stay on Buena. Turn Right on Knight Hill Rd and continue to Lombard Loop Rd. Turn right and go to the Knight Hill Winery, 5330 Lombard Loop Rd.
